Sitting on the banks of the Swan River in Guildford, the new St Vincent's is designed to deliver high quality aged care services and support our Care with Purpose model.

The new two-storey building includes 85 single rooms with ensuite bathrooms, plus one couples suite with a private sitting room. All bedrooms and lounge areas are equipped with multi-media technology such as wi-fi and flat screen smart TVs. All rooms are temperature regulated for the comfort of our residents, families and visitors.

The interior design details and finishes were developed by industry experts. Designed to be sympathetic to the environment, large windows invite the outside in and many of the light and airy rooms have Swan River or native bushland views.

Multiple living areas including spacious lounges, libraries and dining areas encourage social connections between residents, family and carers.

A beautiful internal courtyard and gardens featuring commissioned artworks allow residents to enjoy the outdoors. Quiet and active spaces throughout St Vincent's allow every resident to live their life with Joy, Love and Hospitality.

Wellness and Reablement

Our community based wellness and reablement program is housed in both Bebo Moro and the Day Therapy Centre.

Based on the level of support you need, our team of allied health professionals will create a personalised program that assists you to continue to do the things you love.

Bebo Moro

The Bebo Moro homestead has been retained and restored to its former glory to support our Day Therapy Centre and Residential Facility. It houses a gymnasium, a podiatry room, consultant room, communal lounge and pastoral care office. Bebo Moro is available to eligible members of the community* as well as St Vincent's residents.

The Day Therapy Centre

The Day Therapy Centre provides people in the community with affordable reablement and wellness programs* and offers a range of services to help you maintain, restore or develop your skills.

Services available include:

- Podiatry
- Occupational therapy
- Physiotherapy
- Wellness and reablement program

Additional services can be arranged on a case by case basis to support you to live life to the full.

Services at our Day Therapy Centre are available from the centre four days per week, Monday to Thursday. Podiatry services are available every 4-5 weeks on a Wednesday.
